Election Reminder!

This message is for CFPB Field Employees who must cast their vote (for NTEU) by phone or online: Voting instructions, along with your voter ID number and PIN, were mailed to you on April 18. By now, this information should have arrived at your home. If you haven't already voted, be sure to check your mail this weekend. Look for an envelope from the Federal Labor Relations Authority (not NTEU). That's the envelope that will contain your voter ID and PIN number for voting by phone or online.

If you haven't received your voting instructions, or your partner/spouse may have tossed it out with the trash, or your dog may have eaten it, call the FLRA at 202-357-6029, ext. 6024, to request replacement instructions. If you reach a voice mailbox instead of live person, leave your name and number where you may be reached, even while traveling (e.g., your cell number). You will receive a return call from the FLRA. The FLRA caller will want to verify your name on the eligible voter list and confirm your home mailing address before sending duplicate instructions.

We want to make sure that every NTEU vote is cast, so look for that FLRA envelope. Don't set it aside. **The voting deadline for field employees is May 8.**

Take the few minutes to vote and then look forward to something to celebrate on May 9.
